**SUBJECT: "I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE"
SCRIPTURE: JOHN 6:26-27 (KJV)**

26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled. 27 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

Introduction: Throughout the Bible, inspired writers say many things about the character, conduct, and commission of Jesus. Most of what we know about Jesus is due to what others said about Him.

However, there were times when Jesus did not depend on others to define or declare Him. He did that Himself. There are numerous occasions when you will hear Jesus saying of Himself: "*I Am.*" These words are not new. They are used in a different way.

When God was speaking to Moses about going into Egypt to deliver Israel from bondage, Moses wanted to know whom he should tell had sent him. God said for Moses to tell Israel that His Name was "**I AM WHO I AM**" (Exodus 3:14, NASB). These words say something about the person and presence of God. They literally mean to become or come to pass.
