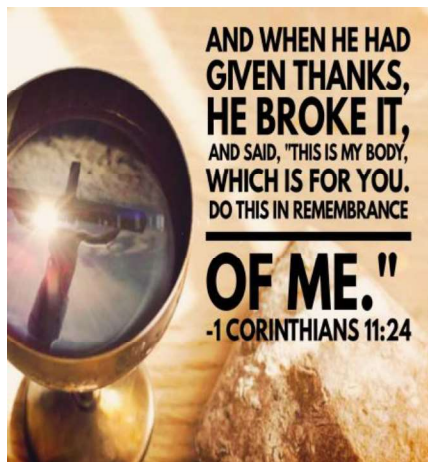

**SUBJECT: "A PANDEMIC OR A PLAGUE"**

**SCRIPTURE:** *"For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord. 13. Now the Blood shall be a sign for you on the house where you are. And when I see the Blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt."* (Exodus 12:12-13)

**INTRODUCTION:** A Pandemic or a plague? The definition of the two is very similar; so why do we choose to use Pandemic over plague? By using Pandemic, we leave God out of the equation. We don't like the word *plague* because it involves God in the event. The word *plague* causes us guilt. It speaks of God passing judgment on a nation or a people. It makes us feel our responsibility for what is happening. It's easier on our conscience to say we're in a Pandemic, than to admit our guilt, mend our ways, pray to God, and ask for His mercy!
