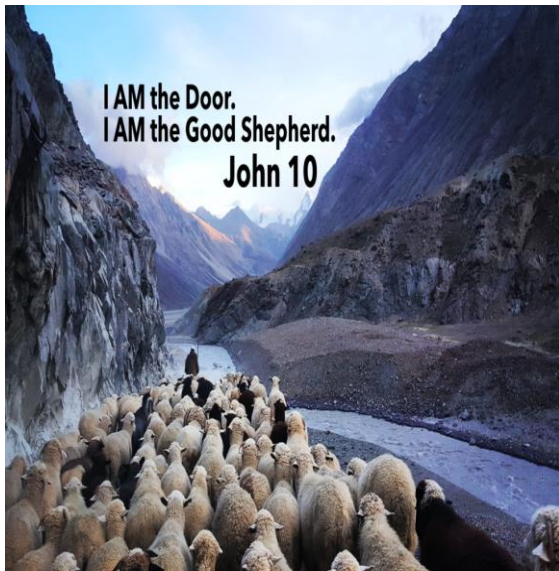

**SUBJECT: I AM THE GOOD SHEPHERD!**

**Scripture: John 10:11, 14 (KJV)**

***<sup>11</sup> I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. <sup>14</sup> I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.***

**INTRODUCTION:** The tenth chapter of John contains two parables of Jesus: The Door of the Sheep, and The Good Shepherd. As the Door, Jesus was illustrating the fact that He is the way of entrance into this new way of life, a way called eternal life.

The Pharisees had claimed to be the door into eternal life, but Jesus said they were thieves and robbers. Any person who attempted to enter the sheepfold without coming through Jesus is a thief and a robber.

In these two parables, Jesus proclaims Himself as both the Door of the Sheep and The Good Shepherd. These claims are pictures of the power and provision of Jesus over and for the sheep. In the presence of Jesus, the sheep are given safety and security.
