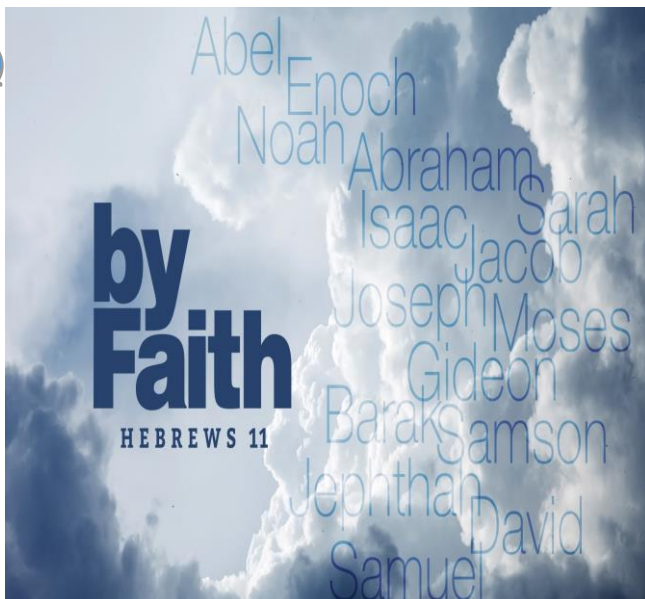

**SUBJECT: LOOKING BEYOND THE MOMENTARY!**

**SCRIPTURE: HEBREWS 11:24-26 (NASB)**

**Scripture: 24** *By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, 25 choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, 26 considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward.*

**INTRODUCTION:** Being caught between two directions is nothing new for man. Since the beginning of time, man has been in a battle between obedience to God and following the desires of his flesh. Since the moment of disloyalty by our fore parents in the Garden of Eden, there has been a strong force within us, trying to pull us away from the will of God.

The original sin of man, I believe, was not the eating of the forbidden fruit in itself; but the sin of believing the lie of the enemy, yielding to the flesh, and turning away from God.

Eating the fruit was just the outward manifestation of what had already taken place in their hearts. They completed the act of disobedience by taking the fruit into their hands and eating it. They preferred to obey the desires of the flesh, in spite of God's warning them of the consequences.

So, Saints, being attracted to things dangling in front of us is nothing new. Nevertheless, we must strive daily to yield not to the temptation of our flesh, but to honor God by obeying His Holy Spirit—remembering the sweet joy and satisfaction we felt in our hearts when we denied ourselves the passing pleasure of sin by **LOOKING BEYOND THE MOMENTARY!**
