**SUBJECT: DON'T WORRY, REJOICE!**

**SCRIPTURE: PHILIPPIANS 4:4-7 (NASB)**

*4 Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice! 5 Let your gentle spirit be known to all men. The Lord is near. 6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

**INTRODUCTION:** We are living in a more turbulent time than ever before. There is so much stress, impatience, friction, and tension everywhere you turn because of COVET 19. Then to make things worse, there is what I call the “*Trumpology*” of fear, bullying, character assassination, threatening healthcare and Social Security, Economic inequality, unemployment, domestic violence, divisiveness, racial injustice, and evil embolden. It's enough to make anybody worry, lose hope, throw in the towel, and give up. So much so that if we are not careful, we will find ourselves at each other's throats with bitterness, anger, and impatience toward one another as we become more worried and anxious.

I'm reminded of a song titled "Don't Worry be Happy" by McFerrin, where the writer tries to encourage his listeners not to worry but to be happy, no matter how bad it gets—perhaps a worldview of how to respond to problems in our lives, but does not guarantee happiness. The Apostle Paul, in this text, gives us biblical principles in overcoming warring to experiencing peace as we rejoice in the Lord.
